This trip has been different. The children's home I recently visited is a transitional center. It serves as a temporary home for children who will eventually be placed in a family. One evening, an adoptive family came to visit us. As we spoke, a sense of redemption and hope flooded me and I want to share it with you.

You remember Luke & Basanti? **They lived in an orphanage for 7 years, but were brought home by their extended relatives with your help!** I wish you could have been with me to see their smiles, to see their adoptive mother playing with Basanti's hair, to see Luke engaging with his new younger brothers. I wish you could have seen the father's proud smile when he talked about his new job that allows him to provide for his growing family. The whole family is thriving.



Luke is doing well in school, loves science and playing soccer. Basanti is passionate about studying English, which you can tell by her delicate accent. She is also very active, playing soccer with her brother and badminton and dance at school. Luke shared that he wants to be a taxi driver when he grows up and Basanti wants to be a dancer.
