Dear brothers and sisters,

We write to you with great thankfulness from our family and from our son German for the financial help that we received from you for German's treatment.

We treasure you and are thankful to God that you have wide, loving hearts. With sensitivity and compassion, you have become close to us through your help for our son in this time of his need. We continue to pray for full healing of German, which is our heart's true desire. However, since that has not occurred yet, we wait and do what we can for him to meet his physical and medical needs. We plan to take German to Kiev this spring to have a full exam with doctors there, which will also try to help diagnosis and treat his slow physical growth and learning disabilities.

We plan to continue this year to try to get as much help as we can for German, including taking him to a speech therapist, getting him child massages, continuing to work on treating his childhood diabetes, etc.

Russia Without Orphans Conference a Great Success!

The movement of national believers caring for orphans in Russia is growing like never before! On March 22-23, 157 delegates from 38 regions of Russia gathered together for a conference hosted by our partners, Russia Without Orphans.

Conference participants attended plenary sessions which were led by Doorways to Hope's Russian and Ukrainian partners. They also met for round table working groups.

Round table discussions were focused on five topics:

- 1) Strengthening families
- 2) Preventing abandonment and orphanhood3) Motivating and furthering a culture of adoption in Russia
- 4) Working with adoptive and foster families 5) Working with orphan graduates

By the end of the conference, participants had put together a document called "The Joint Plan of Action for Russia Without Orphans-2013-2018."

This document will help guide the growth of the Russia Without Orphans movement!

In exciting news, Tatiana Zabolotnaya, a representative of the Russian government's Federal Council attended the Russia Without Orphans event and was very impressed!

She has taken news of the event back to her colleagues and now the Russian Duma's Department for Children's Rights is expressing interest in learning more about Russia Without Orphans and what believers in Russia are doing to care for orphans!
